The Dean's Fund for Students in the Arts Scholarship will be awarded to a student in Art, Dance, Music, or Theatre. The award supports students in the visual and performing arts as they pursue their career goals and creative passions by helping them meet financial expenses associated with their art form (i.e. supplies and materials, costumes, props, sets, instrument repair or purchase, etc.) beyond tuition. Student must have a minimum GPA of 2.8 or higher. Candidates must be enrolled full-time during the 2017-2018 academic year. Students on full scholarships are not eligible. Students must be in good academic standing. Please email applications to kjones@umd.edu, or mail or hand deliver applications to 1120 Francis Scott Key Hall. Include your name at the top of each page.

For consideration of this award, student must submit:

- One letter of recommendation from a University of Maryland faculty member. The letter must be sent directly to the college and from the faculty member's umd.edu email account to the ARHU Scholarship Selection Committee, care of Ms. Karen Jones at kjones@umd.edu. Signed letters on department letterhead can also be sent in a sealed envelope to 1120 Francis Scott Key Hall.
- A two-page, double-spaced essay. Topic:
What impact has your major in the performing and/or visual arts had on you? How will this award help you to fulfill your goals?
- A budget estimate for financial expenses associated with your art form.
