The Catherine P. Mackin Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a student who entered the University of Maryland as a declared major in Arts & Humanities in fall semester 2016, completed at least 12 credits in fall 2016, had a GPA of 3.5 or above for fall 2016, will be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credits in spring 2017, and demonstrates involvement on campus (such as work experience, participation in student groups at UM, etc.) Students on a full scholarship are not eligible. Students must be in good academic standing. Please email applications to kjones@umd.edu, or mail or deliver to 1120 Francis Scott Key Hall. Please include your name at the top of each page. The deadline for applications is Wednesday, April 5, 2017.

For consideration of this award, student must submit:

- A two-page double spaced essay Topic: The transition from high school to college. Describe your experiences as a new student to the University of Maryland. What academic challenges did you face? What factors contributed to your success? What advice would you give a new student to succeed academically?
- One letter of recommendation from a University of Maryland faculty member to be sent directly to the College. The letter must be sent from a university faculty member's umd.edu email account to The ARHU Scholarship Selection Committee, care of Ms. Karen Jones at kjones@umd.edu. Signed letters on department letterhead can also be sent in a sealed envelope to 1120 Francis Scott Key Hall.
