

ON-LINE PROCTORED FLPA

All ARHU majors who may want to seek exemption from the Global Engagement Requirement based on language proficiency must take the FLPT in a proctored setting.

When can I take the Foreign Language Placement Assessment?

Each language test can be taken once per term and may be taken for a total of two times per language. Please note that scores are good for two years:

- Summer/fall term : June 1st - December 31st
- Winter/spring term : January 1st - May 31st

All proctored tests will be administered in Jiménez Hall Room 1205 or in the Tawes Fine Arts Building. Students must [register](#) in advance and arrive promptly at the scheduled start time in order to check in. Once check-in has been completed, the exam will begin and students will have 60 minutes to complete the test.

IMPORTANT NOTICE!

Students will need to bring their own laptops with them in order to complete the proctored FLPA in Jimenez Hall room 1205. A small number of laptops may be available for check out from the lab if you do not have one.

Check-in for the exam will start promptly at the designated time. If students are late, they will need to register for another exam.
